

## Cotton Patch Quilt Guild Harvest of Quilts – 2017 Rules

1. The registration section of the entry form must be received by July 27, 2017. Only the first 125 entries will be accepted. Mail registration form to: Jane Martyn, 1325 CR 1036, Greenville, TX 75401 (903-461-9056). A confirmation will be returned to you.
2. Entries should have the category included on the entry form. However, final decision will be made by the Entry Committee.
3. All entries must remain on display for the duration of the show. Quilts will be released for pickup from 4:00 – 5:00 p.m. Saturday, October 7.
4. A color photo or good color copy of the quilt for identification, with the length and width of the quilt, along with your name address, and phone number, on the back of the photo must accompany each registration form. All photos become the property of the Cotton Patch Quilt Guild and will not be returned.
5. For Cotton Patch Quilt Guild members, a one-time fee of \$5 will be charged for as many entries as you wish. Non-Guild participants will be charged \$5 per entry. Make checks payable to Cotton Patch Quilt Guild.
6. No substitutions of the originally entered quilt will be allowed.
7. All quilts (except category 12) must have been completed after January 1, 2012. No tied quilts or preprinted “cheater” quilt blocks and no un-quilted tops. All items entered must be quilted with the exception of Cathedral Window Quilts, Crazy Quilts and Yo-Yo Quilts. No quilts mounted or framed will be accepted.
8. ENTRANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN INSURANCE ON ALL ENTRIES.
9. Each item is to be enclosed in a pillow case or fabric bag with the submitter’s name, address, and phone number on the bag.
10. Each entry must be clean and in good condition.
11. Your quilt will not be accepted for the show unless the “Hold Harmless” agreement on the registration form has been SIGNED AND DATED.
12. Quilts are to be delivered to Wesley United Methodist Church, 5302 State Highway 69S, Greenville, Texas, on Tuesday, October 6 between 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. All mailed quilts must be received by September 29, 2017. **There will be no exceptions.** You will receive an information packet which will include your shipping/delivery instruction.
13. Every quilt must have a 4” sleeve across the top-back of the quilt, securely hand stitched on top and bottom of casing.
14. Every entry must have a show identification label. Sew the label to the sleeve. This is in addition to your normal label. The label should be fabric, with the quilter’s name and phone number, legibly printed or typed, in indelible ink, and sewn on. Absolutely NO PINS.
15. Any entries “**For Sale**” must be labeled as such and include the price. Any items sold during the show must remain on display through the duration of the show. Sales are between the artist and buyer and not through the Cotton Patch Quilt Guild.

16. The Cotton Patch Quilt Guild reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate or which fails to meet entry requirements.

17. Entries will be judged and ribbons awarded in each category at the judges' discretion.

18. Each entry will receive a judge's critique form.

## CATEGORIES

Each category will receive ribbons, plus Best of Show, Iva Dunaway Best Hand Quilted, Ruth Bacon Award, Elaine Sprague Applique Award, Judge's Choice, Members' Choice and Viewer's Choice.

Category	Size
1.	72" or larger Appliqué, Hand Quilted
2.	72" or larger Appliqué, Machine Quilted
3.	72" or larger Pieced, Hand Quilted
4.	72" or larger Pieced, Machine Quilted
5.	72" or larger – 2 or more persons
6.	Wall less than 72" Appliqué, Hand Quilted
7.	Wall less than 72" Appliqué Machine Quilted
8.	Wall less than 72" Pieced Hand Quilted
9.	Wall less than 72" Pieced, Machine Quilted
10.	Wall less than 72 – 2 or more persons any type
11.	Trish Stuart Challenge –Theme "My Favorite Things"
12.	1 <sup>st</sup> quilt ever exhibited in a show (adult)
13.	Art Quilt - An art quilt is an original design(s), not from a pattern.
14.	Quilt by a child (10 or younger)
15.	Quilt by a child (11–17 years of age)
16.	Any Machine Quilted Quilt that has previously won any first place ribbon or better in a major show (i.e., Paducah, Houston, Dallas, etc.) must be entered in this category.
17.	Any Hand Quilted Quilt that has previously won any first place ribbon or better in a major show (i.e., Paducah, Houston, Dallas, etc.) must be entered in this category.
18.	100" or less miniature quilt, any type constructed to scale
19.	Mixed Techniques (i.e., machine or hand embroidered, crazy quilt, cathedral window)
20.	Non- Judged, Display Only

Top of



Top of sleeve should be 86" from the bottom of quilt. The identification label with name and phone # should be sewn to the sleeve. (Rule 14)
