Dark Blue Print

- (2) 6-7/8" x 6-7/8" squares
- **Light Blue Print**
 - (2) 6-7/8" x 6-7/8" squares



Make Four Half Square Triangle Units



Arrange Units As Shown Above and Sew Into Two Rows

Sew the Rows Together to Finish

- The Pinwheel Block
- 1. Draw a diagonal line, from one corner to the opposite corner, on the reverse side of 2 light blue squares.
- 2. Place 1 light blue square and 1 dark blue square right sides together. Stitch 1/4'' from each side of drawn diagonal line. Repeat for second pair of squares.
- 3. Cut on drawn diagonal line. Press seam allowance towards the dark blue.
- 4. When complete, each of the four half-square triangle units should measure $6-1/2'' \ge 6-1/2''$.
- 5. Arrange the completed 6-1/2" half square triangle units into two rows as shown above. Press seam allowances towards the darker triangles.
- 6. Sew the rows together, matching edges and midpoints carefully. Press the new seam allowance either direction. The quilt block should measure $12-1/2'' \times 12-1/2''$.
